In accordance with Regulation 25 (1)(a) & (b) of the above regulations the Council hereby gives notice of the public consultation of the Issues and Options for the West London Waste Plan. This document is a joint Development Plan Document (DPD) produced on behalf of the London Boroughs of Brent, Ealing, Harrow, Hillingdon, Hounslow and Richmond upon Thames and forms part of the emerging Local Development Framework (LDF) for each of the six boroughs.

The West London Waste Plan (WLWP) will plan for all waste in the six West London Boroughs for the time period up to 2025. The WLWP will aim to provide a planning framework to identify sufficient sites to deal with West London's waste. The Issues and Options document identifies the key issues and suggests possible options as part of the process of formulating the DPD. As well as the Issues and Options report there are additional background documents available including the Evidence Base for the Issues and Options paper and the Sustainability Appraisal.
